

Decision by the Police and Crime Commissioner for Hertfordshire

Item: Crimestoppers Service Level Agreement

Date: 26 January 2021

Decision: The paper was approved at the above Decision-Making Meeting.

The signing of the agreement detailing how the Constabulary works with Crimestoppers was approved.

Background: There is an annual agreement with Crimestoppers for anonymous referrals to police forces, including Hertfordshire Constabulary, of calls with intelligence that may be of value for the prevention or detection of crime. Payment is made for this service and the amount may vary annually. A review of the service level agreement showed that it was no longer fit for purpose and so a revised agreement has been drawn up with the NPCC working group for Crimestoppers.
