Subject: Roads Victim Trust Funding Extension 2026/27

Summary

The Police and Crime Commissioner has agreed to:

- **Approve the allocation of up to £32,500 from the Road Safety Budget to Roads Victim Trust (RVT) for 2026/27**, enabling continuation of support services for Hertfordshire residents affected by serious road collisions until 31 March 2027.
- **Support the continuation of existing funding arrangements** whilst longer-term options for service delivery and commissioning are explored with Bedfordshire and Cambridgeshire OPCCs and BCH Joint Protective Services.
- **Support ongoing work with regional partners to develop a sustainable future funding and commissioning model beyond 2028.**

This decision supports the continued provision of specialist support to road crash victims and their families. The review undertaken identified that RVT provides a well-established service across Bedfordshire, Cambridgeshire and Hertfordshire and remains closely integrated with Roads Policing Family Liaison Officer support arrangements.
