Subject: Hertfordshire Fly Tipping Protocol and Fly Tipping on Private Land Grant Scheme 2026/27

Summary

The Police and Crime Commissioner has agreed to:

- **Approve the Hertfordshire Fly Tipping Protocol**, supporting a consistent countywide approach to the reporting, investigation and management of fly tipping on private land.
- **Approve the opening of the 2026/27 Fly Tipping on Private Land Grant Scheme**, with a total budget of £25,000 available to support victims of fly tipping.
- **Support funding for eligible victims of fly tipping on private land**, including assistance with clearance costs and measures designed to prevent repeat victimisation.
- **Support continued partnership working with local authorities, Hertfordshire Constabulary and other stakeholders** to improve enforcement activity and outcomes relating to fly tipping across Hertfordshire.

This decision supports delivery of the Police and Crime Plan commitment to tackle crime and anti-social behaviour, including rural crime. The protocol and grant scheme aim to improve the response to fly tipping, support victims, encourage investigation and enforcement activity, and reduce the likelihood of repeat offences through preventative measures.
